

**RESOLUTION 2025-34
OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE CITY COUNCIL
ADOPTING THE HISTORIC DESIGN GUIDELINES**

WHEREAS, as part of the comprehensive General Plan 2050 update, Downtown Specific Plan and Zoning Code update, the City has updated the Marysville Historic Design Guidelines, that regulates design of historic structures that contribute to the City's unique character and history; and

WHEREAS, Title 18, Zoning Ordinance, requires Design Review for sites and structures of special historic interest; and

WHEREAS, the original Historic Design Guidelines was produced prior to electronic format technology in black and white print format only. Scanned copies of the original hard copy document are currently posted on the city website;

WHEREAS, the updated Historic Design Guidelines are available electronically and in color and help to streamline review consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Historic Resources;

WHEREAS, the reformatted and updated Historic Design Guidelines supersedes the previous document.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Marysville hereby adopts the Historic Design Guidelines attached as Exhibit A.
